This funding will be used to

- Maintain student achievement in Year 3 NAPLAN at 100% above national minimum standard in 2018.
- Maintain the number of students achieving Leyburn State School Reading targets of 90% from Prep to Year 6.
- Implement Leyburn State School's Whole School Reading Plan.
- Develop a Whole School Writing Plan focused around student attainment of A-E data by 2019.
- Implement behaviour support for identified students in academic and behavioural achievement through utilising the Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) process and targeted intervention.

Our initiatives include

- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the Year level achievement standards.
- Increase teaching staff and support staff's abilities to teach Reading Comprehension and implement Leyburn State School's Whole School Reading Plan.
- Provide support for administration and teaching staff to develop, implement and monitor effective pedagogical practice and planning in key learning areas of English, Mathematics and Science.
- Develop staff capabilities to implement targeted specific improvement in Reading and Writing for each child.

Provide teachers off class time to work with Curriculum and Pedagogy Officer in developing English, Mathematics and Science curriculum.	\$4,080
Provide teacher and teacher aide professional collaborative learning development with cluster schools each Term.	\$4,056
Provide teacher aide support to deliver playgroup activities targeted at pre-Reading, fine and gross motor control, verbal Literacy and school routines.	School Funded
