This funding will be used to

- Maintain student achievement in Year 3 NAPLAN at 100% above national minimum standard in 2018.
- Increase student achievement in Year 5 NAPLAN from 20% (2016) to 50% (2018) in the upper two bands (U2B) in Reading.
- Increase the number of students achieving Leyburn State School reading targets to 90% from Prep to Year 6.
- Develop a whole school writing plan focused around student attainment of A-E data by 2019.
- Implement behaviour support for identified students in academic and behavioural achievement through utilising the Positive Behaviour for Learning process.

Our initiatives include

- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year level achievement standards.
- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching text processing and comprehension across learning areas or subjects.
- Better prepare and support teacher aides to supply additional support in literacy and behaviour.
- Provide support for administration and teaching staff to develop, implement and monitor effective student centred behaviour practices and processes across all grades.
- Develop and implement whole school writing plan aligned with curriculum and reading practices.
