- Ensure that 100% of students reach National Minimum Standard (NMS) in NAPLAN for Reading and Writing.
- Continue to implement and strengthen Teacher capability in actioning Leyburn State School's Whole School Plan and Reading Framework.
- Increase the percentage of students attaining a 'C' or greater in English and Maths.

Our initiatives include


- Provide targeted professional development and coaching to strengthen Teachers' understanding of the Australian Curriculum.
- Provide focussed and intensive intervention by Teacher Aides for students requiring additional support.
- Develop and enact responsive intervention plans that are informed by student data and case meetings with DOE Pathologists and other Professionals.

Funding a Department of Education Speech Language Pathologist fortnightly to assist in the development, support and implementation of Speech, Reading and Literacy intervention programs.	\$13,307.32
Provide professional development opportunities for intentional collaboration between Principal, Teachers and other relevant Department of Education staff and colleagues to enhance student outcomes.	\$1100.00
Funding a Teacher Aide to work with identified students to deliver case management and data informed Literacy intervention programs.	\$8,450.68
