This funding will be used to


- Increase the number of students from Prep to Grade Six, reading at or above Darling Downs South West (DDSW) Regional Benchmarks to 85% by the end of 2020.
- Ensure that 100% of students reach National Minimum Standard (NMS) in NAPLAN for Reading and Writing.
- Continue to write and implement Leyburn State School's Whole School Curriculum Plan and Reading Framework.
- Facilitate whole of school improvement in Reading in relation to the Explicit Improvement Agenda (EIA).
- Increase the percentage of students attaining a 'C' or greater in English, across each year level.

Our initiatives include

- Provide targeted professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum: Literacy, Science, Humanities and Social Sciences (HASS), Technologies, Arts, Languages Other Than English (LOTE) and Health and Physical Education.
- Collaboratively develop a school-wide Reading Framework, with agreed practice for all stakeholders.
- Provide focussed and intensive intervention for students requiring additional support to demonstrate greater achievement against year-level standards.
- Develop responsive intervention plans and action these plans; which are informed by student data and regular case management meetings. This will be completed in collaboration with Department of Education (DoE) Speech Pathologists and other professionals.

Funding a Department of Education Speech-Language Pathologist fortnightly, to assist in the development and support implementation of speech, reading and literacy intervention programs.	\$10, 501.56
